### Membership - Sue Booker, committee chair

Manage/update memberships (new/renewal), membership forms and brochures, announcements/reminders/news, develop one membership drive/project/event a year

## **Communications – Darcel Kimble, committee chair**

Internal/external communications: web and social media content, press releases, develop content for monthly enews for members (work with Sue on membership committee to distribute through Constant Contact) ... develop blog series... HERstory about our community leaders ...

#### **Community Outreach – Salome Johnson, committee chair**

Broad committee that really requires many subcommittees to oversee specific events and activities including participation in parades, festivals/fairs, First Fridays, candidate meet and greets, speakers, movies

#### Issues & Actions – Nancy Rohrbaugh, Kim Martin, Bobbi Proctor

Identify the bills we need to be vocal about, what the issues are and why we are for or against for social media, phone banking, email, letter writing our representatives (love what seeing so far)

## Fundraising – Maribel Burgos, committee chair

Summer PAC Fundraiser, develop ongoing/year-round fundraising opportunity (i.e. selling resistance hats, buttons, T-shirts etc....call on our artists/crafts people to create items we can sell unique to us), and research/apply for grants to bring in speakers and workshops

#### Mentorship - Carol Minnich & Carol Bair

Uplift leaders in our club to service in committee roles, for our executive board (oversee elections every two years in tandem with membership committee), in the community and for public office. Organize events specific to developing leadership and life balancing (i.e. Shawn Fink do a talk on taking care of yourself in the resistance). Would love to see YCFDW offer public schools and colleges meet with our women reps in Harrisburg (Carol Hill Evans/EmergePA)...
